Notes

1. In order to qualify to enter the College of Education’s Teacher Education Program, students must do the following:

- Satisfy the University’s credit hour requirements for admission to a degree plan
- Petition for admission
- Provide transcripts from each college or university the student has attended (reflecting all current/completed semesters)
- Meet College of Education requirements on the THEA: Reading-270; Writing-220; Math-230
- Have a GPA of at least 2.75 (overall or for the last 60 hours, whichever is higher)

2. This degree track at TCC is based on completion of the AA Degree at TCC, which requires the following additional TCC coursework: COSC 1401 or BCIS 1405, PHED 1164, SPCH 1311, 1315, or 1321.
