**Notes**

- In order to qualify to enter the College of Education’s Teacher Education Program, students must do the following:
  - Satisfy the University’s credit hour requirements for admission to a degree plan
  - Petition for admission
  - Provide transcripts from each college or university the student has attended (reflecting all current/completed semesters)
  - Meet College of Education requirements on the THEA: Reading-270; Writing-220; Math-230
  - Have a GPA of at least 2.75 (overall or for the last 60 hours, whichever is higher)
- This degree track at TCC is based on completion of the AA Degree at TCC, which requires the following additional TCC coursework: COSC 1401 or BCIS 1405, PHED 1164.
- Social Science/Cultural Electives should be cleared with the UTA advisor listed above before you take the course to assure effective degree equivalency.
