### Notes

1. Only one math course is required if you transfer to UT Arlington after completing TCC's core curriculum requirements **and** you are an English major. Students should take MATH 1332 at TCC which doesn't have a direct UT Arlington equivalent, but will satisfy the math requirement for English majors at UTA. Students should start and complete their science sequence at TCC.
3. Modern Language classes must all be in the same discipline in order to satisfy the modern language requirements.
4. Social Science/Cultural Electives should be cleared with the UTA advisor listed above before you take the course to assure effective degree equivalency.
5. This degree track at TCC is based on completion of the AA Degree at TCC, which requires the following additional TCC coursework: COSC 1401 or BCIS 1405, PHED 1164, and SPCH 1311, SPCH 1315, or 1321.
