Transfer students admitted to UT Arlington will be classified with a major of Architecture Intended and must meet the following outlined conditions to continue with upper division architecture coursework (3000/4000 level courses).

- 1.) Students must complete all the Architecture Department's basic studies courses, which are the first two years of the architecture courses at UT Arlington, with a UTA Architecture GPA of 2.8 or higher.
- 2.) They must also complete any missing coursework from the School of Architecture's core courses with an overall UT Arlington GPA of 2.8 or higher.

Concurrent enrollment is strongly recommended for transfer students, so that you they can qualify for upper division courses at their time of transfer. Please contact the Architecture Department for more information about concurrent enrollment.

To earn your Associates Degree from TCC you must complete PHED 1164 and 9 hours of electives. Consult your TCC advisor for more details about completing an Associates Degree.
