Walter Nguyen '94



Dr. Walter H. Nguyen is executive director of Mosaic Family Services. Once a Vietnamese refugee, he has spent most of his life in the United States helping other refugees. He began in 1984 working as a bilingual caseworker for Lutheran Social Services of North Dakota, helping unaccompanied Vietnamese minors. He earned his Ph.D. in social work from UT Arlington in 1994 and since that time has been executive director of Mosaic Family Services. Dr. Nguyen received the Distinguished Alumni Award in 2005. This year, he was elected to the 2007 Hall of Fame for the DFW International Community Alliance for his dedication to community services.

Dr. Callicutt retired this year after 40 years on the UT Arlington faculty.
