

Featured Alumnus Dr. Maxwell C. Scarlett '66



Dr. Maxwell C. Scarlett is emergency department physician at Rollins Brook Community Hospital in Lampasas, Texas. He lives in Fort Worth, where he is president and CEO of Lekar Emergency Medical Associates. He received his bachelor's degree in biology from UT Arlington in 1966, becoming the University's first African American graduate. In 1971, he earned his medical degree at Howard University College of Medicine.

Dr. Scarlett received the 2004 UT Arlington Outstanding African American Alumni Award and was an integral part with the formation of the UT Arlington African-American

Alumni Chapter.

He will be receiving the 2007 Dr. Marion J. Brooks Living Legend Award in Medicine, conferred by the Renaissance Cultural Center. Dr. Scarlett was named a Distinguished Alumnus in 2005. He is a Lifetime Member as well as a Circle of Pride member of the Alumni Association.
