POSITION: The Art + Art History Department at the University of Texas Arlington, is seeking candidates for a senior lecturer position in **Film/Video** with emphasis in 2D and 3D Animation, Compositing and Motion Graphics.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates should have a terminal degree or extensive experience. Ideal candidates should have industry experience, as well as a working knowledge of After Effects, Maya, Flash, Dreamweaver, Illustrator, Photoshop, Motion, etc.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Candidates should possess broad design knowledge with the ability to teach in a dynamic, rapidly growing and active Film/Video program. The position includes creative/scholarly activity; student advising; committee and service work. Active presence and participation in area activities and undergraduate curriculum development is required.

THE DEPARTMENT: The Film/Video area is one of the most successful areas within the thriving Art and Art History Department with over 90 majors and four full time faculty.

The area students have been fortunate to have work screened at Sundance, Berlin, AFI Cannes and other major International Festivals as well as receiving a number of Student Academy Award Nominations and been the recipients of numerous major grants and awards. Many have gone on to graduate school in Film or Screenwriting at Yale, Florida State University or AFI. The classes in Narrative Feature Film and Commercial Film offer students experiences and interaction with the film community that prepares them for the real world, without ever forgetting that at our core, we are an Art Department.

The area has been enhanced by the development of an MFA program this past year. This new addition will surely further enhance our already solid reputation as a Film and Video destination school.

A current major technology grant and a full-time computer tech support a well-equipped, state-of-the-art Mac OS computer labs. In addition, the area is supported by a lab assistant, and an elaborate equipment checkout inventory.
