POSITION: Two Visiting Assistant Professors (Senior Lecturers) in **Photography** at the University of Texas at Arlington. Positions start date August 2008. One or two year positions.

QUALIFICATIONS: MFA with a minimum of 2 years teaching experience. Exhibition record a must. Applicant must be conversant with digital technology and document knowledge and teaching experience in one or more of the following: studio photography, color photography, alternative processes, new art forms (such as installation/hybrid applications), digital imaging or history of photography.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Teaching responsibilities include sections of Introduction to Photography (darkroom based), Intermediate Photography (digital base) and upper level sections in area of expertise. Seeking professionals who might contribute to a new BFA track in technology or the MFA Intermedia program. Six courses per year as well as administrative contributions to the area.

THE DEPARTMENT: The Art and Art History department has over 600 majors in eleven studio disciplines. There are twenty five full time faculty. Six studio areas for ceramics, glass, metals, painting, printmaking and sculpture occupy a new 35,000 sq. ft. art complex. Photography, film/video, foundations and art history have large work areas and new computer labs in the Fine Art Building. The photo area supports a complete darkroom facility as well as a full digital printing area with five medium and large format Epson printing stations. The photo area currently has three tenured faculty, two full time appointments and one adjunct position.

THE UNIVERSITY: The University of Texas at Arlington, part of the University of Texas system, is a full service research and teaching university with approximately 25,300 students. The University is located in the City of Arlington in the center of the Dallas-Ft. Worth Metroplex, which has an ethnically diverse population and excellent cultural facilities. The successful candidate must work effectively with students, faculty, and staff from all over the world. UT Arlington is committed to enhancing diversity in its faculty and encourages qualified members of historically under-represented groups to apply.
