

BONE TERMS:

Ramus – convert ram to arm

Trochanter – large and knobby , like a “rock” (roch)

Tuberosity – not as large as a trochanter, sticks out like a “but” (tub backwards)

Tubercle – a little “but”

Condyle – usually paired with a fossa or sulcus

Sulcus – sunken

Trochlea – pulley-shaped

Foramen – an opening

Meatus – a passageway

Sinus – a room

Fissure – a crack in a wall

Squama – flat, squashed

Cuniform – wedge shaped

Ptera – winged
