WAIVER POLICY
THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS ARLINGTON
COLLEGE OF BUSINESS**

At The University of Texas Arlington, graduate business degrees consist of core and advanced level coursework. Core level courses cover the *Common Body of Knowledge* required for all undergraduate business degrees from an AACSB-accredited institution. Depending on candidate's previous undergraduate coursework and performance, the following graduate business Core/Deficiency courses (*Column 1*) may be waived if the candidate has successfully completed, normally with a grade of "B" or better, a counterpart undergraduate course (*Column 2*). Undergraduate courses taken within the last 5 years may be used to earn waivers; undergraduate courses 6 – 10 years old will normally be used to earn waivers if there is adequate knowledge in the field. When undergraduate coursework is over 10 years old, demonstrated continuous professional involvement in the field will be required for consideration of core courses waivers.
