**\*\*MBA Core Course Requirements:**

The MBA degree consists of core and advanced level coursework. Core level courses cover the common body of business knowledge.

1) 3 to 9 hours of core courses may be waived, based on previous business degree(s) earned. A candidate may earn a waiver of the MBA core course(s) pertaining to their major field(s) of study. For example, an undergraduate Finance major may earn a waiver for FINA 5311. Additional core courses may be waived based on prior graduate coursework completed.

2) Minimum MBA program length is 36 hours. If candidate is eligible for more than 9 hours of core course waivers, those hours will be replaced with advanced electives to maintain the required minimum program length.

3) MBA candidates may be able to substitute an advanced elective for a core course within the same discipline. Such substitutions require advance approval from an MBA advisor.

**\*\*\*MBA Advanced Elective Course Requirements:**

- 1) MBA Concentrations are optional. Candidates may maintain a Breadth focus, with no Concentration, by taking no more than 6 elective hours in one discipline.
  - 2) MBA Concentration requires a minimum of 9 elective hours in one discipline, with the exception of Accounting, which requires a minimum of 12 elective hours.
  - 3) Candidates electing to concentrate are limited to a maximum of 15 elective hours of advanced coursework within the designated Concentration.
  - 4) Candidates electing Concentrations may take no more than 6 elective hours in any discipline outside the designated Concentration.
- # A Breadth course substitution is allowed if a prior degree is earned in the respective discipline (e.g., Economics or Accounting).

**NOTE:** Required Core and Advanced (1. through 4., and 9. above) courses do not factor into a designated concentration.
