

Pickens County accountant selected as Oconee County assistant county administrator, finance director

OCONEE COUNTY — Kendra Brown will be the new Oconee County assistant administrator for administration and finance beginning Jan. 26, County Administrator Dale Surrett said this week.

Brown will replace the retiring Phyllis Lombard, who directed the finance, procurement and delinquent tax collections departments of the county government.

Brown will handle those duties that were Lombard's responsibility and also direct the human resources, registrar of deeds, information technology and assessor's offices, Surrett said.

For the past eight and a half years, Brown has worked as an accountant in the Pickens County finance department. Prior to that, she worked as for Clemson University as an internal auditor as well as with a private accounting firm.

She is a Pickens County native and earned a degree in business administration with accounting honors from the University of Texas at Arlington.

Brown is a certified public accountant and certified government finance officer.

Lombard will be on hand for two weeks past Brown's official start date to assist with the transition, according to Surrett.
