Employment Rate

The Employment Rate measures the percentage of MCRP graduates who obtain planning positions or elect to pursue an advanced degree within one year of graduation.

100% of 2015 graduates were employed in full-time planning or planning related positions within one year of graduation. Planning or planning related positions include: Municipal Planning Departments, Neighborhood Planning, as Planners, Planning Technician, Associated Planner and Traffic and Transportation Engineer in Private Consulting Firms.
