

CE Scholarship/Fellowship Criteria

The CE Department Scholarship and Awards Committee utilizes the criteria listed below as part of their decision making process.

Undergraduate student scholarship numbers and amounts are based on the available funding support for each scholarship.

New and continuing graduate students are eligible to apply for a \$1000 Departmental scholarship (\$500 paid in fall and \$500 paid in spring). Award numbers are based on available funding support within the Department and College of Engineering as allocated by the university.

New graduate students are eligible to apply for a \$1000 Master's fellowship (\$500 paid in fall and \$500 paid in spring) or a \$2000 Ph.D. fellowship (\$1000 paid in fall and \$1000 paid in spring). Award numbers are based on available funding through the Graduate School and allocated by the Graduate School and College of Engineering.

Undergraduate Scholarships

Application Deadline: March 15.

- GPA

- Various other factors dependent upon individual scholarship criteria

Continuing Students:

- GPA at UTA
- Number of Hours Completed at UTA
- Involvement with CE Professional and Honor Societies
- Financial Need
- Various other factors dependent upon individual scholarship criteria

Graduate Scholarships

Application Deadline: First Week of September

New Students:

- Good academic standing
- Minimum 3.0 and 3.5 GPA for Master's and Ph.D. students, respectively (Equivalent GPA as per UTA Graduate School)
- Must be registered for at least 9 semester hours of CE coursework
- No Other Form of Financial Support from the Dept/College/University

Continuing Students:

- Good academic standing
- Minimum 3.0 and 3.5 GPA for Master's and Ph.D. students, respectively
- Must be registered for a minimum of 9 semester hours of CE coursework
- No Other Form of Financial Support from the Dept/College/University

Graduate Dean's Fellowships

Nomination Deadline: Last week of August

Students New to Graduate Program Only

- Minimum 3.0 and 3.25 GPA for Master's and Ph.D. students, respectively
- Minimum of 6 credit hours course load per semester
- The award of a Graduate Dean Master's or Doctoral Fellowship does not preclude other financial aid.
