The College of Education and Health Professions at the University of Texas at Arlington invites applicants to apply for three (3) tenured/tenure-track faculty positions at open rank in the Department of Educational Leadership and Policy Studies. Positions will begin Fall 2010. The department serves certification, master's, and doctoral students aspiring to leadership in K-16 educational institutions.

**Qualifications:** Strong candidates will be those with established research interest and grant writing success in the K-16 educational continuum. If candidates do not target a K-16 span within their scholarship, our second priority will be to those with principalship and superintendency established research and grant agendas. Candidates should have a scholarly research record and evidence of pursuing/securing external funding, and those with leadership experience are encouraged to apply.

**Required Experiences and Education:** Successful candidates must have an earned doctorate in educational leadership or a related field and have a developed research agenda in educational leadership and/or policy studies, grant activity, and teaching excellence. Additionally, candidates should have experience advising and chairing doctoral students and dissertations, and a strong commitment to teaching and advising a diverse group of doctoral and master's students with a wide range of interests.

**Salary:** Commensurate with rank

The University of Texas at Arlington, part of the University of Texas System, is a full service research and teaching university with over 28,000 students.
