

**When to Apply to the
College of Education and Health
Professions:**

Make an appointment to see an undergraduate [Education advisor](#) (5th floor Carlisle Hall) as soon as possible after you have completed the core curriculum. Be sure to bring the Academic Advisement Report that you received from your [Content advisor](#).

Other Things to Know:

You must have attained:

- a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75, which will be calculated by an Education advisor, and
- the required THEA scores (270-Reading; 230-Math; 220-Writing).

Please note that you may have to attend summer sessions, or an extra full semester, in order to complete all of your Content courses two semesters before starting your Student Teaching.

Secondary Teaching Certification Sequence (Grades 8-12) for Content Majors

**4 full semesters
prior to graduation:**

1. Start taking prerequisite courses:

EDML 4300,

EDTC 4301,

LIST 4343.*

*LIST 4343 may be taken in the Field-Based Experience semester in order to maintain fulltime status.

2. Take Content courses.

**3 full semesters
prior to graduation:**

1. Finish prerequisite courses.

2. Finish all Content courses.

3. [Apply for Field-Based Experience](#):

- Due March 1st for FALL Field-Based Experience, or
- Due October 1st for SPRING Field-Based Experience

**2 full semesters
prior to graduation:**

1. Take pedagogy courses:

EDUC 4341,
EDUC 4342, and
EDUC 4352.

2. LIST 4343 may be taken in the Field-Based Experience semester in order to maintain fulltime status.

You will be in the schools 6 hours per week.

**1 full semester
prior to
graduation:**

1. Take Student Teaching course:

EDUC 4647.

You will be in the schools five days a week, 40 hours a week, for 18 weeks (following the school district calendar).
