**PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The following requirements must be met prior to beginning the Education course sequence.

- 1. GPA of 2.75 or higher (Overall or 'Last 60')**  
 This is a cumulative GPA which includes transfer coursework.
- 2. THEA scores: Reading - 270, Writing - 220, Math - 230**  
 The COEHP Reading score is higher than the standard passing score of 230. No other exam may substitute for the THEA.
- 3. 18 or fewer hours of core/content courses remaining**  
 All core/content courses are given in the left column. Any remaining hours must be completed prior to Second Year.
- 4. GPA of 2.75 or higher in each content area**

Students must maintain a 2.75 Education GPA and earn grades of 'C' or better in all Education coursework.
