



PRE-PHARMACY STUDIES

Curriculum

The pre-pharmacy curriculum consists of approximately two years of full time coursework. Required classes include math, science, and general education course work. The typical grade average for accepted applicants is approximately 3.5, but this can vary slightly from year to year. Highly competitive applicants will have Pharmacy College Aptitude Test (PCAT) scores in the upper 25% of those individuals taking the test. If possible, students should take the PCAT in October of the year preceding entry to pharmacy school. The PCAT may be repeated, if necessary, in January of the year of entry.
