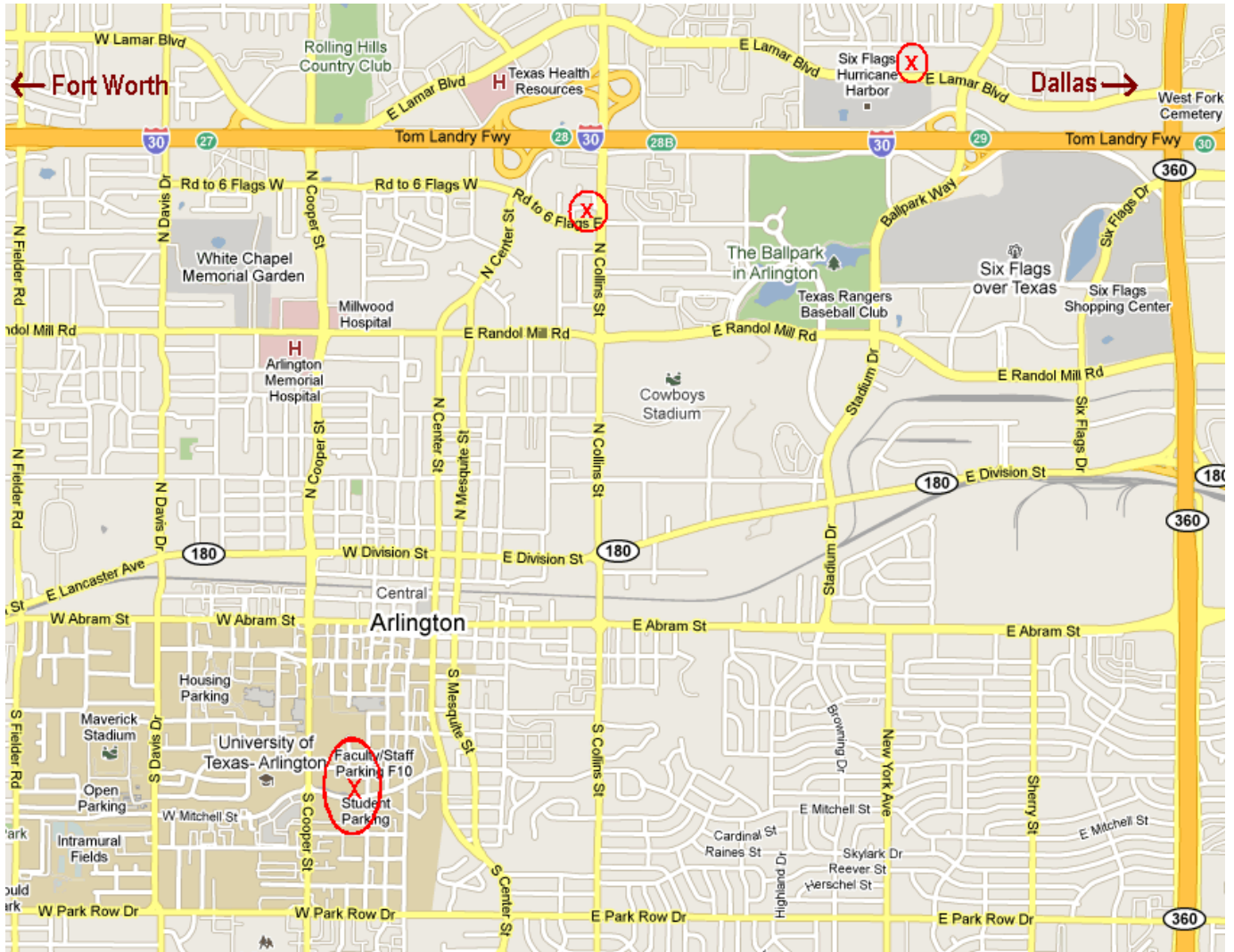


For **Friday's session**, we will meet on the 6th floor of UT Arlington's Central Library.

The three circled “x” locations indicated are, from top to bottom, the Marriot Hotel, Colter’s BBQ, and the conference location at UT Arlington. The next two maps zoom in on the UT Arlington location.



The “X” locations on this map indicate the approximate points of entry to the student parking lot, which will be available for your use. Follow the red line across the pedestrian bridge, through the faculty parking lot, and to the Central Library (Friday’s location) or to the Life Sciences building (Saturday’s location). The endpoint arrows indicate the building entrance locations.

The circled “S” indicates the hotel shuttle drop-off/pick-up location.
