- Promoting a coordinated effort within the insurance industry to combat insurance fraud

- Developing greater awareness of the insurance fraud problem
- Encouraging high professional standards of conduct among insurance investigators
- Supporting legislation that acts as a deterrent to the crime of insurance fraud.

They must be of good character and demonstrate sincere motivation and dedication to the investigative field of study. These attributes are demonstrated by the applicant's academic accomplishments, extracurricular activities, employment history, community activities and leadership qualities.

GUIDELINES:

- The amount of the 2006 scholarship is \$1,500.00 awarded to one candidate.
- The scholarship recipient will be recognized and awarded at the June 2006 Chapter meeting.
- The award is for the Fall 2006 academic school year to help defray tuition or related expenses, and it is made payable to the college or university on behalf of the recipient.

ELIGIBILITY:

- U.S. citizen, a Texas resident with residence in Dallas or an adjacent and surrounding county
- Pursuing an undergraduate degree major related to the Administration of Justice
- 30 semester hours completed with an overall 3.0 G.P.A. for competed studies from prior semesters
- Full time student status during the application period at an accredited Texas college or university

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Complete scholarship application
- Two letters of recommendation from preferably a school faculty member
- Certified copy of the official transcript, which details all completed semester's grades
- Application signed and dated
- Application accepted by U.S. mail only. It may be postmarked no later than March 1, 2006
