

# Association of Environmental & Engineering Geologists Texas Section Scholarship Application



## Objective

The Texas Section of the Association of Environmental & Engineering Geologists offers two scholarships each year to qualified students. The scholarships, one to a senior year undergraduate student and one to a first or second year graduate student, were established to promote the study of geology, engineering geology, hydrogeology, or related earth science disciplines.

## Eligibility

Applicants must be in at least their junior year for the undergraduate scholarship and their first year of graduate school for the graduate scholarship. Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited four year college, university, or professional school and have a declared major in geology, engineering geology, hydrogeology, or a related earth science discipline. Applicants must have an overall grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, with a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 in geology, engineering geology or hydrogeology related courses.

## Evaluation

Evaluation of applicants shall be by a committee composed of members of the Texas Section of the Association of Environmental and Engineering Geologists. The evaluation shall rate the applicants based on the following rating factors:

- (1) Educational Standing - 30%
- (2) Student Activities and Extra-curricular Activities - 45%
- (3) Objectives, Need and Application Appearance - 25%

## Amount

A total of two scholarships will be awarded. One scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a senior year undergraduate student, and one scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a first or second year graduate student.

## How to Apply

Applicants for the senior year undergraduate scholarship should apply during their junior year and applicants for the graduate scholarship should apply during their first year of graduate school. The completed application form, transcripts (official or photocopy), a two-page (maximum) typed essay describing the applicant and their educational and professional goals, and at least one letter of recommendation (sealed by author) should be submitted to the Secretary of the Texas Section AEG. The name and address of the current secretary is included on the application form. Applications are to be submitted by **Monday, March 22, 2010**. Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 30, 2010.
