

Job Announcement: Senior Lecturer in English

The University of Texas at Arlington invites applications for a full-time, non-tenure-track lecturer in English with a preferable start date of Spring 2010.

Primary responsibilities are teaching and some committee work. The teaching load is 4/3 divided between lower-level courses in writing or literature, including Introduction to Textual Analysis and Interpretation (2350), and selected upper-division courses (depending on expertise) in one or more of the following: American Literature, British Literature, World Literature, Technical Writing, and/or Creative Writing. Summer and other inter-session teaching is also a possibility. While the position carries no research expectations, travel money is available to present academic work at conferences. The successful candidate will have a terminal degree in his or her field of expertise (Ph.D. in English, Rhetoric and Composition, or Comparative Literature) and a track record of successful teaching.

Compensation includes full benefits package. Screening of applications will begin on November 9th, and the position will remain open until filled.
