

UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT ARLINGTON
TUITION REBATE FOR BACHELOR DEGREE GRADUATES

TEXAS RESIDENTS ENTERING A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE
FALL 1997 SEMESTER OR LATER MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A TUITION REBATE OF UP TO
\$1,000 UPON GRADUATING.

(This program is authorized by Texas Education Code, section 54.0065)

To be eligible for a rebate under this program, a student must meet **all** of the following conditions:

1. Must have enrolled for the first time in an institution of higher education in the Fall 1997 semester or later,
2. Must be requesting a rebate for work related to a first baccalaureate degree received from a Texas public university,
3. Must have been a resident of Texas at all time while pursuing degree and have been entitled to pay resident tuition at all times while pursuing the degree,
4. Must graduate with a four year degree in four calendar years or within five calendar years for a five year degree (Beginning with students enrolled for the first time in Fall 2005), and
5. Must have attempted no more than three hours in excess of the minimum number of semester credit hours required to complete the degree under a specific catalog. **Hours attempted include transfer credits, credit by examination, courses that are dropped after census date, for-credit developmental courses, optional internship and cooperative education courses and repeated courses.**
6. Student must apply for rebate prior to receiving the baccalaureate degree.
7. Tuition rebate shall be reduced by the amount of any outstanding student loan, including an emergency loan, owed to or guaranteed by the state, including the Texas Guaranteed Student Loan Corporation.
