### ***CPS Policy***

- 10% of your grade is based on homework/attendance/class participation.  
Half will be from WebAssign.  
Half will be from class participation with CPS.
- Your CPS participation grade will be determined in various ways, based on the question asked. For some questions, you will receive full credit, regardless of whether your answer is correct. For other questions, you will receive partial credit for incorrect answers. Even if you are unsure of the answer, it *always* pays to give it your best attempt.
- You should *only* use the CPS unit registered in your name. If you use a friend's unit to cover for his or her absence, or if you ask another student to use your clicker on a day that you are absent, this will be considered a serious violation of UTA's policy regarding academic integrity, and you will fail the course.
- If you are absent, your CPS grade for that day will be a zero. However, the three lowest CPS daily grades will be dropped.
- If for any reason you do not bring your CPS unit to class, you will not be counted present, and you will receive a zero for that day's participation grade.
- You will not receive CPS credit for the day if any of the following events occur:
  - the batteries go out
  - you arrive in class too late to “join”
  - you do not register appropriately with CPS
- You should keep track of your CPS username and password. In the event that your CPS unit is lost, you will not have to pay another registration fee if you have your username and password.
