⁴Coursework older than 5 years must be reviewed by ELPS faculty with approval conditions made on individual basis. Transfer credit will be limited to a maximum of 9 semester credit hours in M.Ed. program and a maximum of 6 SCH in Principal Certification Only program. Must take four core courses (5381, 5382, 5383, 5384) at UTA

⁵ Effective Fall 2004 requirements: two of three minimum scores: 500 verbal, 500 quantitative, 4 analytical writing

⁶Bar code eligibility requires successful completion of 5381, 5382, 5383, 5384, 5330, minimum 80% practice test score, post-practice test review with COE representative

⁷Upon completion (not before) of all requirements, graduates should apply directly to SBEC (www.sbec.state.tx.us) for certification. Temporary certification is only good for 5 years and usually is obtained only if it is a district requirement.
