Program Overview

The Master of Science in Information Systems (MSIS) Cohort Program consists of a set of industry-focused courses built on a foundation of business core principles culminating in an integrated capstone class and industry related project. The objective of this program is to provide managers of various functional business areas the necessary knowledge to effectively interface with the Information Technology organization. All the key functional areas of business such as accounting, economics, finance, management, and marketing are integrated in the curriculum throughout the program.

Upon completion of the program graduates will understand the fundamental principles of these functional areas and how they apply in an information systems context. More importantly, graduates will have developed the mindset necessary to assess and effectively interact with an IT organization in a fast-paced, ever-changing technological environment, lead more effectively, and help their organization adapt and grow to meet future challenges.

Classes meet Tuesday and Thursday evenings

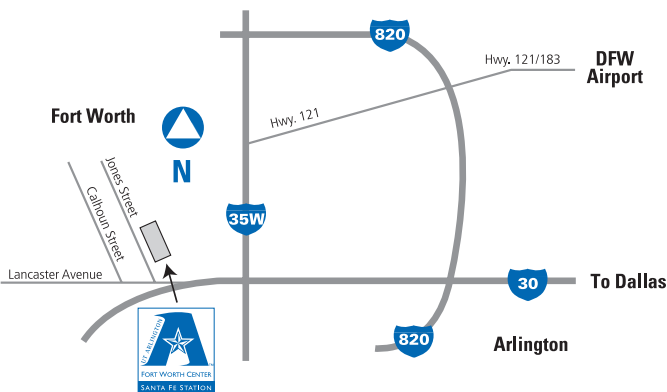
