Your letter to Dr. Pam Haws on July 12, 2005, requested that The University of Texas at Arlington submit a combined substantive change prospectus for the programs offered at UT Arlington/Fort Worth Center. You will find that document enclosed.

The initial location for the Fort Worth Center (Riverbend Park) was the site of UT Arlington's Automation and Robotics Research Institute (ARRI), at 7300 Jack Newell Boulevard South, Fort Worth, Texas, 76118. Per this letter, we would like to notify the Commission that UT Arlington has obtained additional space at 1401 Jones Street, Fort Worth, Texas, 76102 (Santa Fe Station). Our plan is to begin classes at this location in Fall 2006. The new site will become the primary location of the Fort Worth Center where new cohorts of the Accelerated MBA, Executive MBA, Health Care Administration and Engineering Management program will be offered. The M Ed with Principal Certification and the Systems Engineering program will continue at Riverbend Park.
