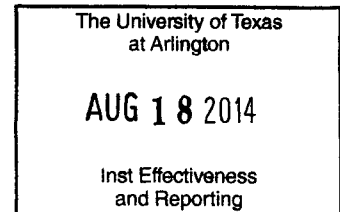

Dear Dr. Karbhari:

Thank you for your letter of June 6, 2014, notifying SACSCOC of your intention to implement two new degree programs, effective fall 2014. The two new programs are:


- M.S. in Business Analytics
- B.A. in Spanish Translation and Interpreting

The M.A. in Business Analytics is a 36 credit hour degree program. The program is closely related to a track option in the M.S. in Information Systems degree program. Only three new courses, less than 25% of the curriculum, will be developed to support the program. The remaining courses are already being offered in the curriculum.

The B.A. in Spanish Translation and Interpreting is a 120 credit hour degree program. The Department of Modern Languages already offers a certificate in this area. Only two new courses will be added to the program, representing less than 25% of the required coursework.

Since the two programs come from similar programs and existing coursework, they do not represent a significant departure from existing programs. **We acknowledge the information and will add it to the file.**
