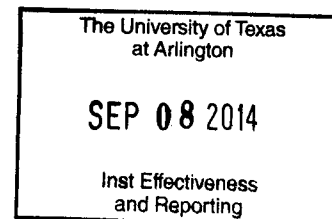

Thank you for your letter of June 24, 2014, providing notification of plans to offer the Bachelor of Science in Architectural Engineering degree program, effective fall 2014.

The 120 semester credit hour degree program will consist of existing courses from programs offered in architecture and engineering along with less than 25% of new courses. Existing faculty members will teach in the program and no additional resources will be required.

Because the program is not significantly different from approved programs currently offered and will require no new faculty or other resources, it is not considered to be a substantive change requiring approval.
