Thank you for your letter of notification dated August 16, 2013, regarding the University of Texas at Arlington's intent to offer the following existing programs via on-line delivery, effective fall 2013:

- Neonatal Nurse Practitioner (NNP) Master of Science in Nursing (M.S.N.) degree program
- Post-Master of Science in Nursing Neonatal Nurse Practitioner certificate program


Students may enroll either as full-time or part-time students. Preceptor clinical experiences will occur primarily in the student's place of employment under the direction of clinical preceptors approved by the University of Texas at Arlington College of Nursing faculty.

The on-line program curriculum will mirror the existing curriculum with minor exceptions made to accommodate on-line delivery. The institution is approved for distance learning/on-line delivery.

**The Commission on Colleges accepts notification and will add this information to the institution's files.**

Please note that effective January 1, 2013, once an institution is approved to offer electronically 50% or more of the credits in a program, no notification is necessary when any percentage of additional approved programs is offered online.
