Thank you for your letter of notification, dated June 18, 2013, regarding the establishment of a cooperative program agreement between the University of Texas at Arlington (UT Arlington) and Angelo State University (ASU) to offer a joint Master of Science in Social Work (M.S.S.W.) degree program (38 credit hours), effective fall of 2013.

The proposed M.S.S.W. degree program will be delivered in a mixed format to a cohort of approximately 25 students. Seventeen (17) program credits will be completed in a traditional classroom setting at ASU; the remaining 21 credits will be completed online via the UT Arlington School of Social Work. A signed copy of the M.S.S.W. joint program agreement accompanied the letter of notification.
