Dear Dr. Wheelan:

I am writing to notify the Commission that The University of Texas at Arlington (UT Arlington) plans to offer an online Master of Science in Nursing Executive Nursing Administration Program (ENADM) beginning in August 2010. UT Arlington already has Commission approval to offer the regular MSN on line.

The curriculum for the ENADM is consistent with the current Nursing Administration Program, but is specifically designed to meet the needs of nurses currently in management/leadership positions who wish to complete an MSN with a focus in administration. The 15-month online program incorporates the core curriculum required of all MSN graduates of the College of Nursing, builds on the current MSN in Nursing Administration curriculum, and expands the leadership and management knowledge and skills of the experienced nurse manager/leader.

In addition to online courses, two courses incorporate face-to-face components which will emphasize global health care issues and their potential applications to the USA: two project weekends in Fort Worth as part of one course and a two-week international travel component as part of another.

As with all our programs, the course content, course structure, and final course grades are the sole responsibility of the University of Texas at Arlington.
