Thank you for your letter of August 12, 2010, notifying the Commission on Colleges of a location change for one of the off-site programs.

Effective August 26, 2010, the approved Bachelor of Business Administration completion program will be offered at the new instructional site at the Trinity River Campus of Tarrant County College. This site replaces the UT Arlington Fort Worth Higher Education Center (Santa Fe Station). The street address of the new location is:

Fort Worth, TX, 76102

The program will remain the same, with 4 to 5 classes per semester offered, taught by UT Arlington faculty.

Since, according to the email of September 21, 2010, from Dr. Pamela Haws, you will be offering less than 50% of the credits in the program at the instructional site in Fort Worth, TX, we accept the notification and require no additional information. Please remember that if 50% or more of the credits for the program are taught at an off-campus instructional site, our policies require notification at least six months prior to implementation and a prospectus for review and approval at least three months prior to reaching the 50% point.
