Thank you for your letter of August 16, 2010, notifying the Commission on Colleges of the intent to offer and the documentation to support the Professional M.B.A. (P.M.B.A.) program in Frisco, Texas, beginning January 2011. The P.M.B.A. at this site will follow the same format as the previously reviewed site in Fort Worth, Texas. The curriculum, method of delivery, teaching methodology, calendar, library services, onsite support, and student services will be very similar or identical to the existing site.

Information About the Site, Facilities, and Student Services

Physical resources:

The Frisco, Texas program will be offered at:

This is a 50,000 square foot facility which includes 10,000 square feet of shared space and administrative offices. NTEC is currently in the process of constructing a classroom within the facility to accommodate the program. The facility includes high-speed internet access, wireless in-office connectivity, data and digital/IP telephony voice communications, and presentation and projection equipment.

Library resources:

Students will have full access to UT Arlington library database system online. There are many research-oriented databases, articles, and journals in the business discipline available for students. The contact information of the business librarian will be provided to students so that they can obtain the necessary assistance.

Student support services:

One to two dedicated staff, depending on class size will be available.

Faculty:

Nineteen faculty were identified and satisfactory credentials provided.
