The effective date for implementation of the program at this site is October 15, 2010. A copy of the signed agreement with the Global Institute of Management was provided.

As noted in our letter dated April 12, 2010, a modified prospectus accompanied the letter. The program will be offered in cooperation with Global Institute of Management, which will coordinate the recruiting and administrative aspects of the program. UT-Arlington will provide the faculty and fully control all academic issues. Faculty qualifications, physical facilities, access to library and learning resources, and student support services appear appropriate.
