Dear Dr. Wheelan:

I am writing to notify the Commission on Colleges of the University's intent to offer the Master of Science in Real Estate at an off-campus location.

In December 1985, The University of Texas at Arlington (UT Arlington) received approval from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board to offer the Master of Science in Real Estate degree on the Arlington campus. Beginning in August 2009, UT Arlington plans to offer the program to the UT Arlington Fort Worth Higher Education Center – Santa Fe Station. The address of the Fort Worth Center is 1401 Jones Street, Fort Worth, Texas, 76102.

The 36-hour curriculum is identical to that of the previously approved on-campus program. At the Fort Worth center, the curriculum will be offered in a rolling cohort format in which students can enter the program in any semester (spring, summer, fall). Classes will be delivered one course at a time in accelerated 5-week sessions, and the program can be completed in 15 months. Classes will be taught by faculty from the Arlington campus who will travel to the Fort Worth location for face-to-face instruction. The program is to commence in the fall 2009 semester.
