This letter is to notify the Commission of an off-site location. The University of Texas at Arlington (UTA) will initiate the process for establishing an off-site location for instruction at Beijing University of Posts and Telecommunications (BUPT). This off-site location will be used for delivering a few classes for our Master of Science in Information Systems.

We expect to offer 25% of the instruction for the masters degree in Information Systems by the **fall semester 2016**. The remaining courses for the degree will be offered to the cohort of students on the UTA campus. Students receiving instruction for this degree begin with three courses at BUPT and complete the remaining coursework through instruction delivered on the campus of UTA. The degree will be granted by The University of Texas at Arlington.

Faculty members teaching the courses at the BUPT site are the qualified faculty of UTA.
