Dear Dr. Karbhari:

Thank you for your letter of July 7, 2016, notifying the Commission of the intent to offer the Bachelor of Science in Construction Management degree program beginning December 2016. The institution is currently seeking approval for the 120-credit hour program from the University of Texas System and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

Existing programs in the Department of Civil Engineering include the Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering, Bachelor of Science in Architectural Engineering, Master of Science in Civil Engineering, Master of Engineering in Civil Engineering, Master of Construction Management, and Ph.D. in Civil Engineering. One additional tenure-track faculty member and a full-time senior lecturer are in the process of being hired; four additional senior lecturers will be hired over four years to accommodate anticipated program growth. The program will seek accreditation from the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology. The program does not appear to be a significant departure from existing programs.

We accept the notification of the Bachelor of Science in Construction Management degree and require no additional information.
