## UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS

The UTTER (Undergraduate Training in Theoretical Ecology Research) Program in the Departments of Mathematics and Biology at the University of Texas at Arlington invites qualified undergraduate students to apply for UTTER scholarships. The scholarships provide each recipient with two years of financial support for a total of **\$11,400**. Undergraduate students with at least two years remaining to complete their B.S. degree will be considered for these scholarships. Students from groups underrepresented in the sciences are especially encouraged to apply. In order to qualify for the UTTER scholarships, students must

- be a United States citizen, national, or permanent resident at the time of application,
- be pursuing a bachelor's degree in Mathematics or Biology at UT Arlington,
- be enrolled full-time (12 or more credits) during the semester receiving the scholarship,
- have completed both UTTER program prerequisites:
  - BIOL 1441. *Cell and Molecular Biology*; and
  - MATH 1426. *Calculus I*,or other equivalent courses,
- commit to completing the UTTER program courses, seminars and an interdisciplinary research project, during the two years of support.

Application deadline is **March 31, 2010**. Late applications will be considered only if scholarship funds are still available. Detailed application instructions and application form can be downloaded from the following website:
