

UTA CORE CURRICULUM

The Core Curriculum is a set of approximately 44 hours of courses (3 to 4 semesters) that are required no matter which major a student selects at UTA. Some majors may require specific courses to meet a Core requirement. English Composition	6 hours—ENGL 1301 and ENGL 1302		
Literature	3 hours—English Literature OR foreign language literature		
Liberal Arts Elective	3 hours—2000, 3000, or 4000 level (above Freshman level) Any sophomore level or higher course in the College of Liberal Arts: ADVT, ANTH, ART, BCMN, CLAS, COMM, CRCJ, DNCE, ENGL, FREN, GEOG, GERM, GREK, HIST, HUMA, JOUR, LATN, LING, MAS, MUSI, PHIL, POLS, PORT, PREL, RUSS, SOCI, SPAN, SPCH, THEA, or WOMS.		
History	6 hours-- HIST 1311 AND HIST 1312 (<i>History of United States I and II</i>)	OR	6 hours— (Educ. majors) HIST 1311 <u>or</u> 1312 (<i>U.S. History</i>) AND HIST 3363 <u>or</u> 3364 (<i>Texas History</i>)
Political Science	6 hours—POLS 2311 (<i>Government of the U.S.</i>) and POLS 2312 (<i>State and Local Government</i>)		
Mathematics	6 hours—Consult the <i>UTA Undergraduate Catalog</i> (www.uta.edu/catalog/) to determine the required math courses for your intended major.		
Natural Science	8 hours minimum—LAB science in the same science chosen from BIOL, CHEM, GEOL, or PHYS (includes astronomy). Consult the <i>UTA Undergraduate Catalog</i> (www.uta.edu/catalog/) to determine the required science courses for your intended major.		
Social/Cultural Studies Elective	3 hours—archaeology (ANTH), CLAS, COMM, ECON, HIST, HUMA LING, MAS, PHIL POLS, social or cultural ANTH, social/political/cultural GEOG, social PSYC, SOCI, or WOMS; see the following web site for approved courses: http://uac.uta.edu/socialcultural.htm		
Fine Arts Appreciation	3 hours—ART, DNCE, MUSI, THEA, or ARCH, see the following web site for approved courses: http://uac.uta.edu/finearts.htm
