**Instructions:** The University of Texas at Arlington (UTA) and the Women's Health Nurse Practitioner Certificate Program at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas have formed a cooperative agreement to facilitate the transition of their graduates into graduate study at UTA so that they might obtain a Master of Science in Nursing. Students seeking an MSN with specialization as an Acute Care NP, Family NP, Gerontology NP, Adult NP, Pediatric NP or Psychiatric-Mental Health NP must have completed the Women's Health Nurse Practitioner Certificate Program and will need to apply and meet the admission requirements for UTA. Students in this program would have to complete a minimum of 48-51 graduate hours. Students will receive course credit for a maximum of 9 hours from UT Southwestern and will need to take a minimum of 39 hours from UTA. **In order to receive credit for the 9 hours taken at UT Southwestern, this form must be completed and returned to the Graduate Nursing Office as soon as possible.** All courses taken at UT Southwestern must have a grade of "B" or better. An official transcript reflecting these courses must be on file in the Graduate School. The University of Texas at Arlington will be responsible for conferring the Master of Science in Nursing degree and providing documentation of this preparation to the Board of Nurse Examiners and to the American Nurses Credentialing Center.
