

Drug Screen Policy for RN's Clinical Eligibility

UTA School of Nursing

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The Dallas Fort Worth Hospital Council has implemented requirements for clinical eligibility for nursing students (graduate and undergraduate). In order to meet the clinical agency eligibility, current students must provide evidence of all required immunizations as well as evidence of a negative urine drug screen and a negative criminal background check. Failure to conform to clinical eligibility will prevent the student from participating in clinical courses and may affect course progression. The urine drug screen must be done at the University of Texas at Arlington Student Health Center no more than 3 months prior to first clinical class. Results are confidential and are only disclosed to the Dean (or her designee), School of Nursing. You need to have all of your prescription medications in their original bottles with you at the time of the drug screen. You will be responsible for payment of the drug screen and the estimated cost is \$30.00. The Student Health Center is open daily from 8:00–4:30 (M-F) and Saturdays (10:00-1:00).
