

# -IN CHECKLIST

## Mav Express



Before arriving, you will need to get your Mav ID card which is your student ID. Your Mav ID is used to get into your hall, room, parking lot, and meal plan. The Mav Express Office is located in the University Center. You will need to have your Mav Express card with you for check in.

## Telephone



You will need to bring your own telephone. No long distance services are offered.

## Linens



You will need to bring your own pillow, linens and towels. The mattresses are twin size of varied lengths. In Arlington, Brazos, Kalpana Chawla, Trinity, and Lipscomb North they are 39 x 80 x 6 and in Lipscomb South they are 39 x 75 x 6. All windows have 1 venetian blind.

We offer four different meal plans tailored to meet our residents' needs. Arlington Hall and Kalpana Chawla Hall residents are required to participate in a meal plan. ## Carpet



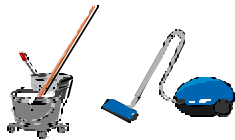
All residence hall rooms have wall-to-wall carpet in an assortment of colors.

## Mailbox



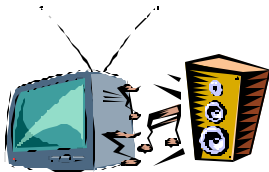
You have a mailbox assigned to you in the University Center since there is no delivery in the halls. When you move in, please stop by the Mail Box in the University Center to find out your box number. You will need to pay a deposit for the box key.

## Cleaning

## For Your Safety



We ask that you do not cook in your room with the exception of microwave ovens and blenders. Each hall has a community kitchen for you to use. You may bring a refrigerator that does not exceed 4.3 cubic feet. Arlington Hall has one refrigerator per suite and one per double occupancy room. All other cooking appliances are not allowed. Extension cords are not allowed, only power strips equipped with surge protectors. Candles are only allowed if the wick is cut or completely removed. Clothes, curling, and flat irons are allowed only if equipped with automatic shut-off.
