Interested in attending an IRB Meeting? Research “greater than minimal risk” must receive full board review at a convened IRB meeting. Participants of this session will have the opportunity to experience what it is like to “attend” an IRB meeting through a mock Full Board protocol review. IRB members will consist of attendee volunteers as well as actual UTA IRB members and administrators. Attendees will gain an understanding of the ethical implications, human subject protection concerns, and risk/benefit analyses that are typically considered during an IRB review. Attendees will learn the different outcomes of an IRB review, and what to expect as a researcher after a protocol has gone through a Full Board review process.

This interactive session will provide guidance for developing and submitting an IRB protocol application. This seminar will cover the various types of research involving human subjects and offer helpful examples for completing study-related documents for a more expeditious IRB approval. Study material examples will include IRB applications as well as developing effective and appropriate informed consent documents and recruitment materials. Attendees will gain an in-depth understanding of IRB considerations during approval reviews. Learn about common mistakes and how to avoid them. Attendees will be given the opportunity to ask questions related to their specific research protocols (bring a draft!).
