**Remarks:**

**Whereas:** Graduate students at the University of Texas at Arlington are restricted to a \$100 or 1,000 one sided page print quota per year; and

**Whereas:** Graduate students are expected to print more than traditional students especially during their final semesters when presenting theses and dissertations; and

**Whereas:** Graduate students enrolled in thesis or dissertation hours pay the normal tuition rates and need less of the time of faculty staff, and services;

**Whereas:** Graduate Students at other Universities, such as the University of North Texas, have additional printing privileges for students in their final semesters;

**Be it Therefore Resolved That:** UT Arlington allow the funds from thesis and dissertation tuition to fund an additional quota of 1,000 pages or \$100 of free printing per each semester that students are enrolled in at least 6

thesis, thesis equivalent, capstone, or dissertation hours and a charge of \$.05 for the next 500 pages after the additional quota.
