Whereas: Graduate students are encouraged to produce publishable documents that enhance the public profile of the university; and

Whereas: Graduate Students spend a great deal of their time on campus engaged in these research activities, yet are not provided with a space to safely store materials and books;

Be it Therefore Resolved That: UT Arlington graduate students be provided with accessible study carrels available for rent at a nominal fee in the Central Library for the ongoing support of their academic research. It is recommended that the funding for carrels be used from the Library Enhancement fee.
