the conference is as follows:

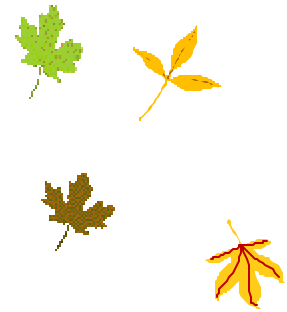
