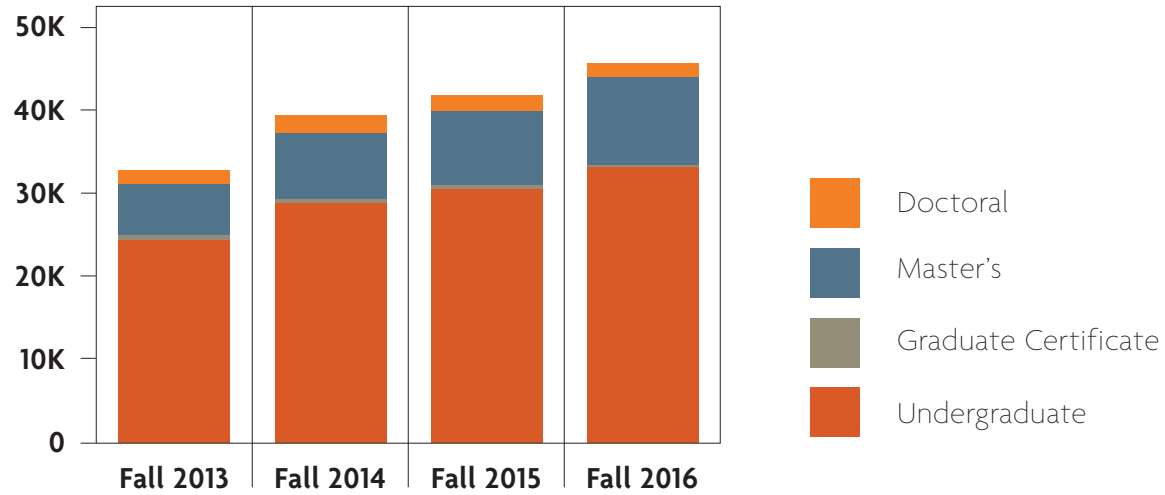


ENROLLMENT

Over the past four years, UTA experienced rapid growth reaching 45,282 students in Fall 2016. Master's enrollment represents the largest proportion of growth during this time.

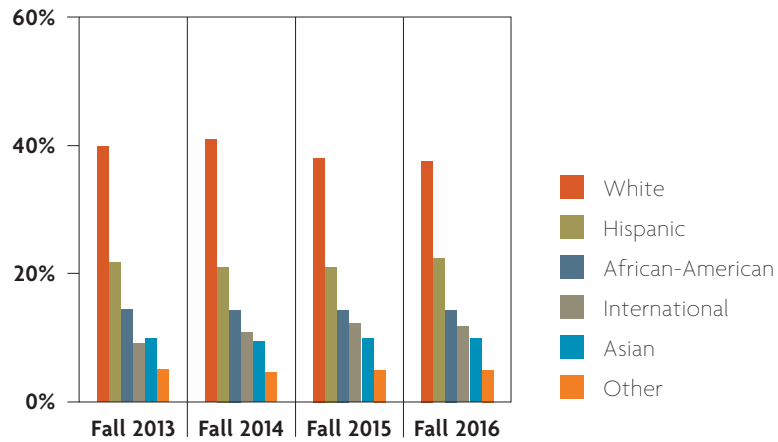

Race and Ethnicity

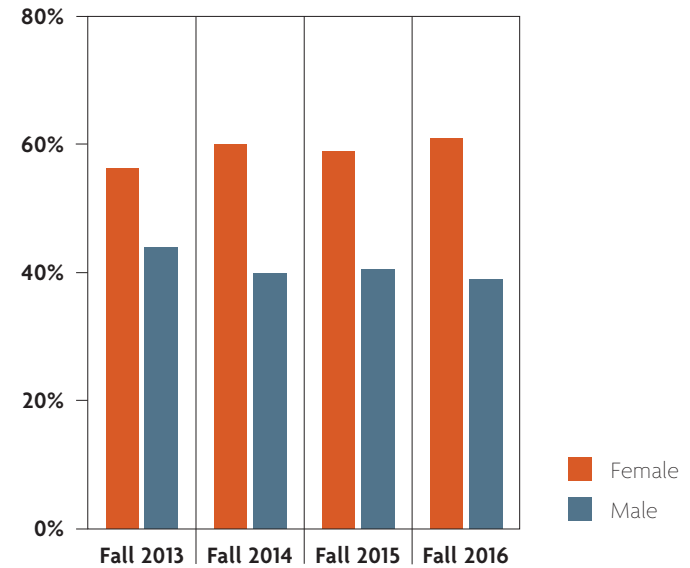
Minority enrollment has increased in recent years, with Hispanic and African-American students now accounting for over 37% of enrollment.

The ratio of female to male students at UTA has been changing in the last four years, with the female student population increasing.

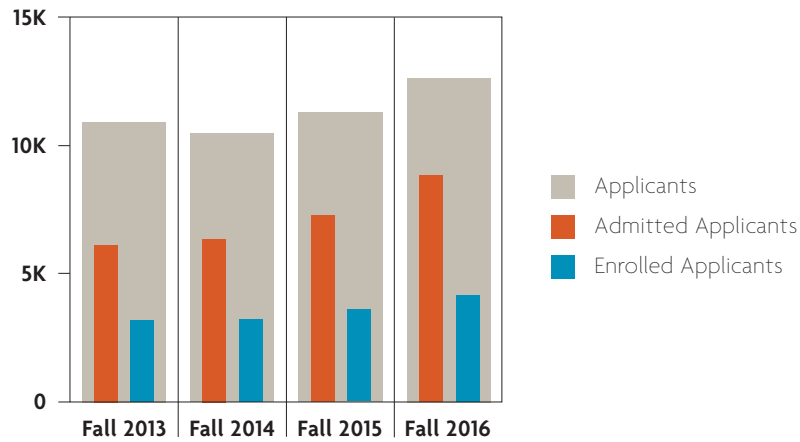

Freshman Admissions

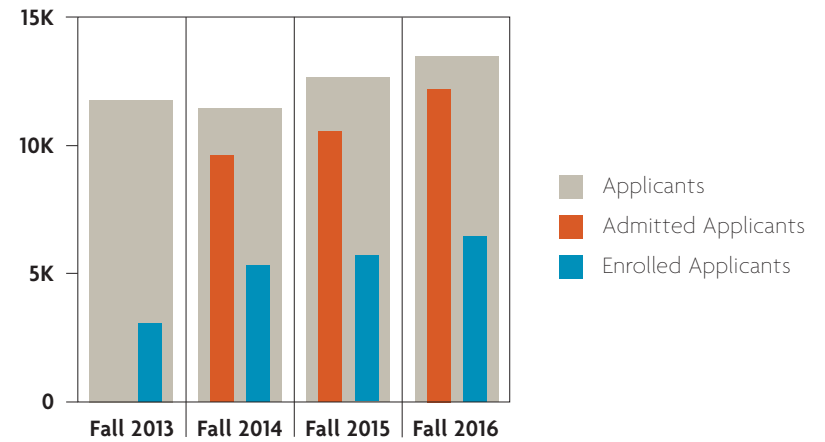
There has been a steady increase in the number of freshman applications at UTA.

There has been a steady increase in the number of new transfer student applications at UTA.

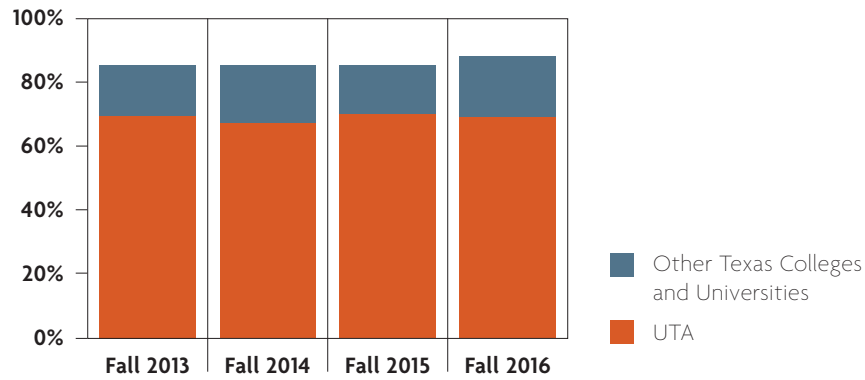

Freshman 1-Year Retention Rate

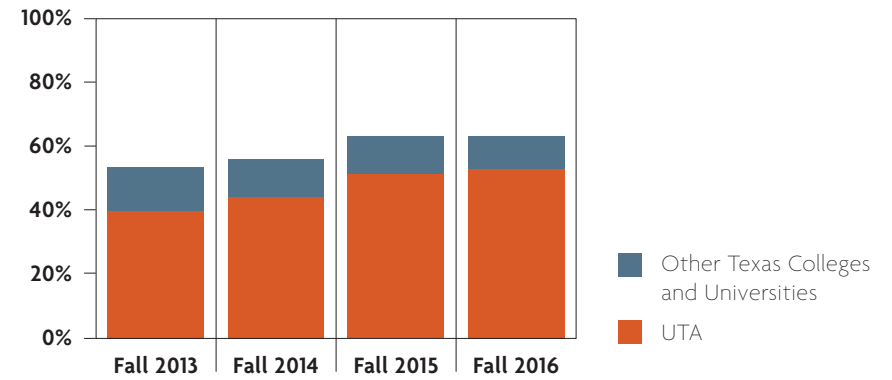

6-Year Graduation Rate

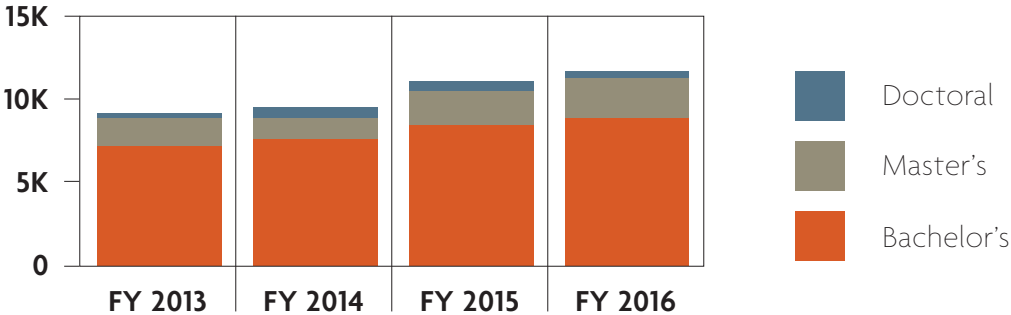
Forty-seven percent of students who started in Fall 2016 graduated from UTA within six years.

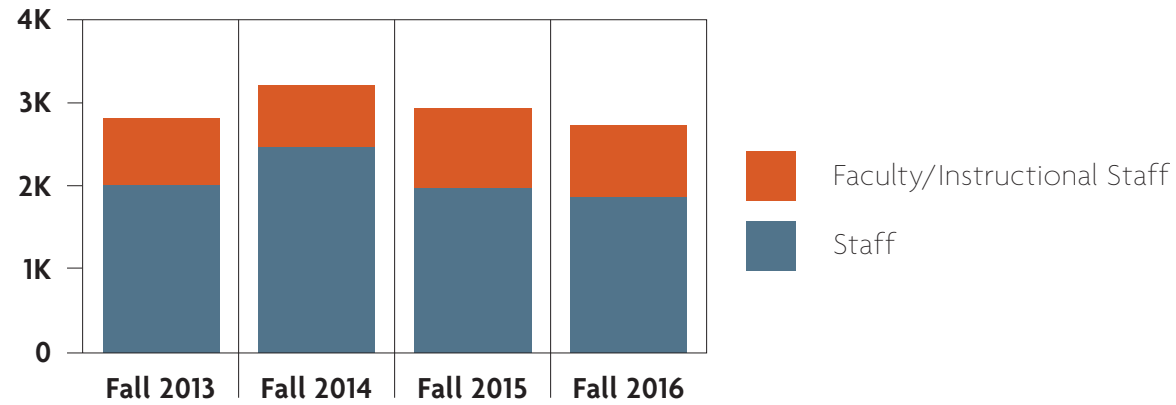
DEGREES AWARDED

During the 2015-16 academic year, UTA awarded a total of 11,526 degrees, not including certificates.



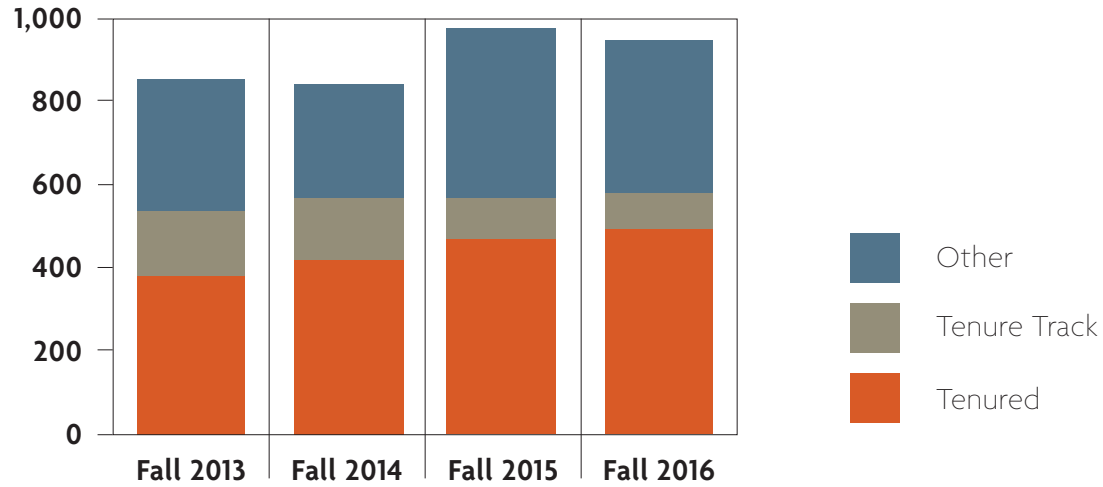

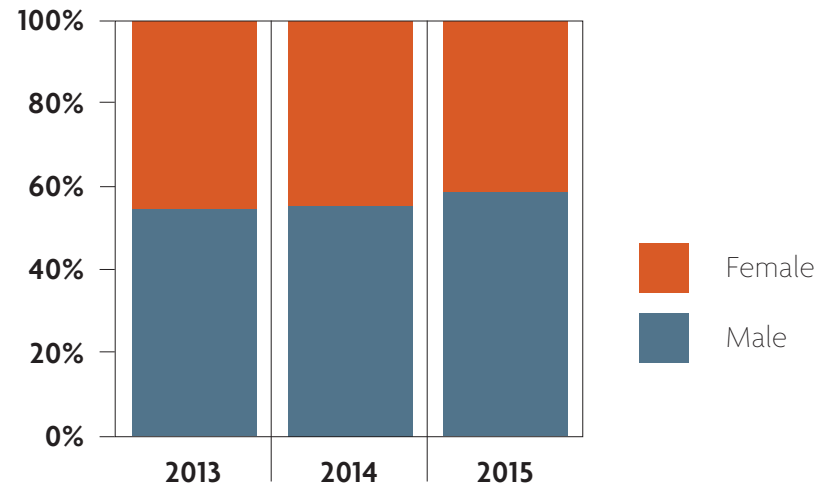
