

Important Announcement about English Dept. Scholarships

- Eligible students must apply for scholarships through Mav ScholarShop (<https://uta.academicworks.com/>). Search by name of scholarship.
- Deadline for applications is March, 30, 2017.
- Letters of recommendation should be submitted via email (yael.sasley@uta.edu) or by hard copy to the English Dept. office by March 30, 2017.

Scholarships and Requirements

College of Liberal Arts - English- Emory D. Estes Endowment funds scholarships for students who meet the following criteria: (Goes towards the next semester's tuition)

- Graduate of UT Arlington's undergraduate English program
 - Have at least 12 hours of course work in UT Arlington's M.A. in English program and enrolled full time.
 - A minimum GPA of 3.5
 - Preference will be given to students majoring in literature
1. A statement, of no more than 1 page, outlining your reasons for pursuing an advanced degree in English and your academic goals for the future.
 2. An essay of at least 10 pages in length demonstrating your proficiency in a field of English Studies. The essay may be one previously submitted for an undergraduate or graduate class.
 3. Three letters of reference, from English professors in the graduate program at UT Arlington.
 4. Upload unofficial transcript

College of Liberal Arts - English- Evelyn Anita Sawyer Ray Endowed Scholarship gives *preference* to returning students who attended college after high school (or within a year of high school) but had to withdraw from college due to unforeseen circumstances, and decided to return at a time later in life (at least 1 year after withdrawing). (Goes towards the next semester's tuition)

Eligibility:

- returning student with a declared English major at UTA
 - At least six hours in upper-level English courses
 - Overall GPA of 3.5
1. A statement, of no more than 1 page, outlining your reasons for pursuing an advanced degree in English and your goals for the future.
 2. An essay of at least 6 pages in length demonstrating your proficiency in a field of English Studies. The essay may be one previously submitted for an undergraduate English class
 3. Three letters of reference, from English professors who have taught you at UT Arlington.
 4. Upload unofficial transcript

College of Liberal Arts - English- **Shakespeare Club of Arlington Scholarship** for students who meet the following criteria: (Goes towards the next semester's tuition)

- Students eligible for admission to the University of Texas at Arlington or those that are continuing in good standing at the University,
 - Citizens of the United States or are legal residents of the United States will be eligible for consideration.
 - Junior English majors currently enrolled at UTA and beginning full-time senior year course work, and senior English majors currently enrolled at UTA and engaged in senior year course work, and graduates of UTA's English Department entering UTA's M. A. in English program.
 - Overall GPA of 3.25
 - Completion of at least twelve hours in English classes at UT Arlington, at least nine of them at the advanced (3000/4000) level
1. A statement, of no more than one page, outlining your reasons for pursuing a degree in English and your academic goals for the future.
 2. An essay of at least six pages in length demonstrating your proficiency in a field of English Studies. (The essay may be a revision of one you previously submitted for a class.)
 3. Three letters of reference, from English professors who have taught you at UT Arlington.
 4. Upload unofficial transcript

College of Liberal Arts - English- **Philip Cohen and Elaina McMillan Endowed Graduate Fellowship**

(This award may be renewed in subsequent years)

(Award goes directly to the recipient with direct deposit)

- Must be enrolled full time in the PhD program
 - Must hold a GTA/EGTA assistantship in the English Department
 - Recipients must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.5
1. Write a statement of research interests and goals (500 words max)
 2. Need 3 letters of recommendation from a UTA Graduate faculty
 3. Upload unofficial transcript

College of Liberal Arts - English- **Roy Mullins Endowed Scholarship** Annual scholarship or graduate fellowship

(Goes towards the next semester's tuition)

- Preference is given to those out of secondary school 18+ years (Junior College, College, or University)
 - Must be an undergraduate or graduate student in English
1. A statement, of no more than one page, outlining your reasons for pursuing a degree in English and your academic goals for the future.
 2. An essay of at least six pages in length demonstrating your proficiency in a field of English Studies. (The essay may be a revision of one you previously submitted for a class.)
 3. Three letters of reference, from English professors who have taught you at UT Arlington.
 4. Upload unofficial transcript
