All applicants will be interviewed beginning in December 2017. **Interviews will be scheduled only with students who have submitted a complete application, which consists of the following:**

- This form, completely filled out (PRINT LEGIBLY IN BLACK INK) and signed;
- A check payable to the University of Texas at Arlington in the amount of \$500*; and
- A one- or two-page typed personal statement introducing yourself to the faculty and stating your reasons for wanting to participate in this program.

American citizens do not need a tourist visa to enter Peru. International students might need a visa, depending on their country of citizenship; they should contact the Consulate-General of Peru in Dallas.

If you anticipate traveling abroad in summer 2018, whether with this or another academic program, or on your own, you are urged to apply for a passport promptly, since delays are common in the spring.

*The deposit of \$500 is necessary to hold a place in the program. Students who cannot be offered a place in the program will have their deposits returned in full **until the deadline of April 13** (see below).

The fee for participating in the 2018 Honors College Study Abroad Program in Peru is \$2500. If you interview for a place but decide not to attend, you will be eligible for a full refund of the deposit. If interviewed and offered admission, you will have one week to confirm acceptance, and you must submit payment for the balance of the program fee as soon as possible, but in no case later than March 30, to hold your place in the program. If the full deposit is not received by that date, you risk forfeiting your place, and it will be offered to another student.

Students who confirm acceptance and pay the entire fee, and who subsequently decide to withdraw, will be eligible for a full refund if notice is received in writing by 5:00 pm on Friday, April 13. Thereafter, no refunds will be made for any reason. Withdrawal notices must be addressed in writing to Jim Perry at the address below.

All participants are required to register for both ART 4392 and ENGL 2309 (Summer Term I), and all must depart DFW on or before May 29th and be in Lima Airport in time for the group flight from Lima to Cusco on May 30th. All participants are required to be present for the entire term of the program; departures may not be scheduled before June 15th. Detailed instructions and recommendations about foreign travel will be provided in several information and orientation sessions in the spring semester.

NOTA BENE: Submission of an application does not guarantee acceptance to the program. No student should purchase airline tickets or make any other travel arrangements before receiving a letter of acceptance.
